Fee Schedule

Effective January, 2016

1. Valuation of Project

All proposed projects will be assigned a value based on the following:

• Dwelling units (new construction and additions)	\$150.00/Sq. Ft.
• Commercial and industrial new construction and additions	200.00/Sq. Ft.
• Commercial accessory buildings	50.00/Sq. Ft.
• Conversion of non residential space to living space	120.00/Sq. Ft.
• Basement renovations	50.00/Sq. Ft.
• Residential garages, accessory buildings & non-living space	40.00/Sq. Ft.
• Agricultural Barns	30.00/Sq. Ft.
• Conversion of non-commercial /industrial space to comm/indust	150.00/Sq. Ft.
• Pre-engineered metal commercial buildings	75.00/Sq. Ft.

↳ In cases where square footage is not relevant, fee will be based on a *sound* estimate of cost as determined by the Building Inspector.

2. Fees

Upon determination of project cost, fees shall be assessed at a rate of \$6.50 per \$1,000.00 of value. There shall be a minimum fee in all cases of \$55 except as noted below.

3. Other Fees

• Siding, windows, reroofing	\$6.50 per thousand - \$55 minimum
• Change of use & occupancy (no structural renovations)	\$55
• In ground pool \$100	Above ground pool \$55
• Temporary dwelling or construction trailer	\$55
• Permit for residential foundation only	\$55
• Wood stove or chimney permit	\$55
• Replacement of permit card or other certificate	\$20
• Stop work order (posted and lifted)	\$55
• Re-inspection fee	\$35
• Signs (minimum fee is \$55)	\$1 per Sq. Ft.
• Demolition	\$55
• Plan review on exceptionally large or complicated projects	\$45 per hour
• Inspections requested when not related to any issuance of permit	\$55

Fees will be doubled when construction is started prior to issuance of permit.

Special note on wood stoves:

Fee for wood stove permit will be waived in one and two family construction if proposed installation is noted by applicant as part of application for permit to construct or alter residence.
