
2024 Envelope Guide




(2020 ballot kit shown above)

AV8:

AV8 is for domestic voters to return their EV/AV ballots by mail. The AV8 is white, is pre-addressed to your offices and includes postage paid for by the State. It is *required* to be used in all state and local elections for EV and AV by-mail voters.




AV11:

The AV11 is used by election officials to mail absentee ballots to domestic EV/AV voters. This is the outer-most envelope of kitted ballots which includes the AV8, a ballot and instruction sheet. The current version of the AV11 is white (not a brown paper bag) and simply says "BALLOT ENCLOSED" under the return address—no longer listing the date or the election type so it may be used in all state and local elections.




EV7:

The EV7 is the smallest envelope that must be sent or provided to every Early Voter whether by-mail or in-person. *You must insert an EV7 into your kitted ballots before you mail them.* Below is an image of the envelope we are manufacturing for 2024. It will be on a lighter "brown kraft" color shown below as opposed to the paper bag material we were stuck with in 2020, and will feature a "peel and seal" strip. We have also added a red arrow where the voter signs and added more space below the signature line for you to affix a label.




AV7:

AV7 is the inner-most absentee envelope with an affidavit that is filled out by every *absentee* voter who receives their ballot by mail. *You must insert an AV7 into any kits being sent to AV voters.* Upon completion of voting, they seal their voted ballot in the AV7 and execute the affidavit on the envelope. The AV7 is then put inside of an AV8 or SAV8 and brought to a mailbox or delivered to a City/Town Hall. The 2024 AV7 will have a "peel and seal" strip.




SAV8:

Used for a foreign or military absentee voter to return their ballot to City/Town hall. The AV7 containing the ballot is placed into the SAV8 for mailing.



SAV7:

SAV7 is for overseas absentee voters to receive their absentee ballot package. This is the outermost envelope for citizens voting abroad.



PV:

In the event a voter casts a provisional ballot their ballot will be kept in the PV envelope until such time it is determined that the ballot will be counted.

E 230A:

The E 230A is used for communities with hand counted, paper ballots (sans optical scan). Enclosed are paper ballots in blocks of 50. Also enclosed will be a block-tally sheet used for recording.
