Contract Amendment #1:

Agreement By and Between

Pioneer Valley Planning Commission and Town of Chesterfield

For MVP 2.0 Planning Services

BY MUTUAL AGREEMENT, as evidenced by the attached signatures, the original Agreement effective as of the 18th day of October 2023 by and between the Pioneer Valley Planning Commission (Commission) and the Town of Chesterfield (Town) is hereby amended effective January 23, 2024 to reflect the following changes:

1. ATTACHMENT B: Revised Budget & Timeline

The original contract shall be increased by Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000), for a total contract amount not to exceed Forty Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$45,000). Below is the budget for the completion of the MVP 2.0 Process with a corresponding updated timeline. The primary vendor will assume responsibility of compensating Community Liaisons, hosting engagement events (providing food, activities for children, etc.) and has also included travel reimbursement. The primary vendor will also serve as subject matter advisor for the seed plan implementation plan or assume responsibility to sub-contract it out of additional expertise are needed.
